Congratulations to **Jay Jay and Graeme Carley** who took out the End of Month Doubles Pool Comp and won the \$100 bar tab.

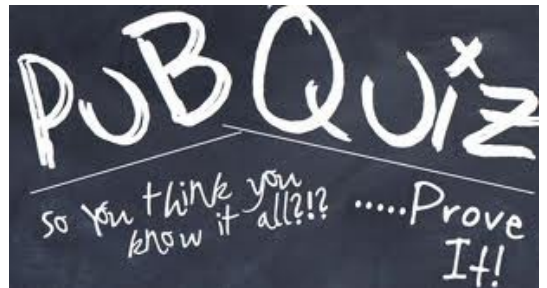
Our next end of month comp will be on Sunday 31 August
